ccTLDs Rules and Regulation update

- Most ccTLDs require a local presence. In order to complete the registration, you
 must be a resident of the sponsoring country.
- ICANN requires annual registration with a maximum of 10 years.
 - Some ccTLDs registries require a minimum of two years and
 - Others limit maximum registration to less than 10.
- If a domain expires, the domain's registry may charge a fee. Each registry has its own rules on assessment of fees, as well as their own associated fees.

Staying up to date with the rules and regulations is important. Because each country and culture vary, knowing beforehand can save you time and simplify the process. It's easier than you think.

Privacy and Security

Online privacy and security is always at the forefront when it comes to registering a domain name. But what about registering in another country? It is important to know who is providing the security for you and your business.

Many ccTLDs require that the contact information for the domain's local presence be published. Privacy and protection services, which shield your personal contact information on the public WHOIS databases, are not available for ccTLDs requiring published information.

Don't let these differences deter you – ccTLDs provide the best option of an online presence. **Just know the Facts:** research rules and regulations related to your ccTLD.
